Largest Snow Ball - As a group build the biggest snowball on the flag field and then see how far it can roll?

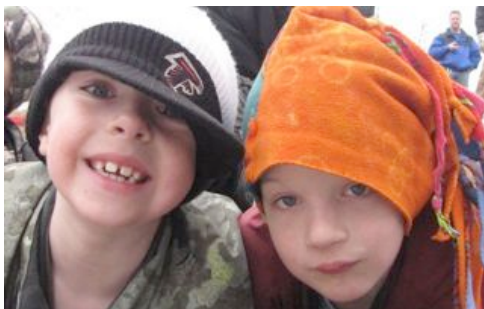
Nature Hike - Checkout what you can't see when there are no leaves and other foliage. A whole new environment waits to be explored! Meet at the Dining Hall.

Meet at 4:30 pm in front of the Nature Lodge. Sign up during registration.

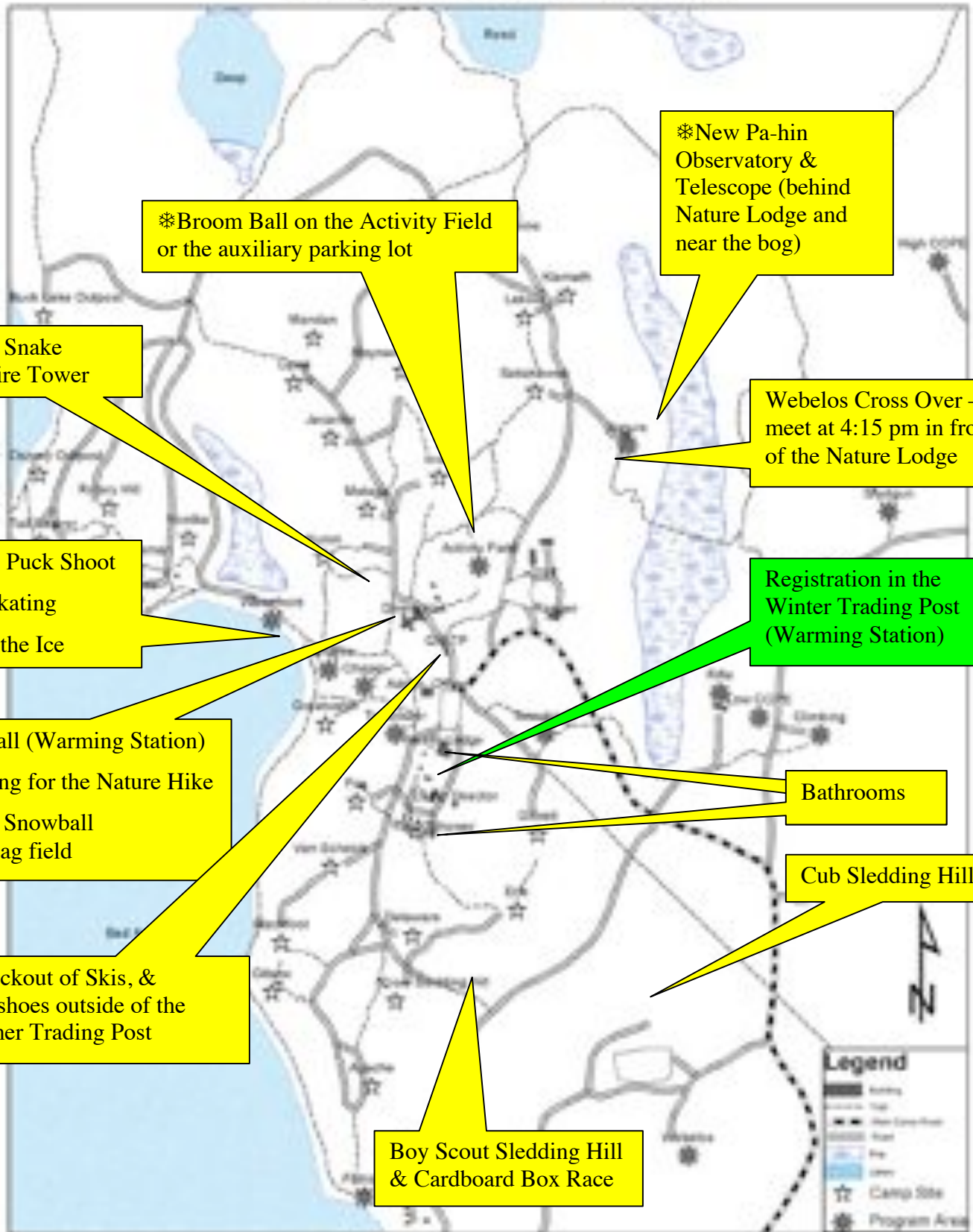
